#### **Funding Focuses:**

Funds raised will be invested in 3 strategic projects blessing every NCA student on campus for years to come.

- Replacing the well-loved Early Learning play structure & reimagining the large play area to create 3 dynamic Early Learning playgrounds with previous Auction contributions & Walk-a-thon donations.
- We are expanding our award-winning STEAM program with an integrated Horticultural Sciences Program for Elementary & Middle School students. Donations will fund phase 1 and equip an on-site classroom greenhouse laboratory where students will deepen their understanding of science, sustainability, and biblical principles through immersive, hands-on, naturebased learning.
- A portion of the funding will also be used for our annual NCA Teacher Excellence Awards.

We do not stock shirts- they are ordered weekly as donations are generated.</li> <li>Where supply chain issues arise, NCA reserves the right to substitute T-shirts with a similar color or another Walk-a-Thon T-shirt color option.</li> </ul>			
Tie-Dye T-shirt	<ul> <li>The Tie-Dye T-shirt option is a Middle School incentive and is ONLY available for current 5th-8th graders (1 per student).</li> <li>If more than one tie-dye T-shirt is selected, it will be substituted with a solid color T-shirt. If Early Learning up to 4th grade selects the tie-dye T-shirt, it will be substituted with a solid color T-shirt.</li> </ul>			
No Exchanges	There are no T-shirt exchanges. T-shirts are screen printed & ordered weekly based on your submitted preferences.			
Walk-a-Thon Dress Policy	For Spring 2025: Students may wear the 2025 Walk-a-Thon T-shirt or sweatshirt with blue jeans or uniform bottoms, including PE sweats and uniform shorts for the remainder of the school year (except Wednesdays for elementary students).  • Middle School Students: Dress code guidelines still apply. PE uniform bottoms may only be worn on the student's PE days.  For 2025-26 School Year: Students may wear their 2025 Walk-a-Thon T-shirt with blue jeans or uniform bottoms on Fridays. The 2025 Walk-a-Thon sweatshirt may be worn as a uniform hoodie throughout the school year. The 2024 T-shirt will be retired May 30.

Walk-a-Thon T-shirts are not delivered the same week as the donation is made. Mondays at 5:30pm on April 28, May 5, 12, 19, and 26 are the weekly deadlines for donation earning totals to "activate" a shirt for delivery the next week. #### **WALK-A-THON CELEBRATION DETAILS:**

- Each class walks as a group with their "homeroom". Parents, grandparents, and families are welcome to walk with the class or line the route. <u>This is a</u> <u>stroller friendly event</u> – <u>No</u> pets please.
- Parents are also invited to tailgate in the parking lot around the course perimeter. Bring lawn chairs, cheer on the students with noisemakers, bubbles, pom poms, etc.! Prizes will be given out for the best tailgating!
  - Bring on the water: Adults may bring water dispensing devices to squirt water on the students at the K-2nd and 3rd-8th grade walks <u>as long as they meet our safety standards</u>. Students may <u>not</u> dispense water on adults. The "plunger or syringe" type of devices are NOT allowed...any size or shape, purchased or homemade.
- The Walks at 9:45am and 11:00am will include the student beloved bubble foam pit and spray area!
- Our **Annual Volunteer Appreciation will be Breakfast this year:** June 6 from 8:30-9:30am. If you volunteered this year in any capacity large or small, then this breakfast is for you!
- Parking will be very tight. Offsite parking will be available and street parking. Our gates will be closed during the walk times. Parking instructions will be emailed closer to the event date.
- Our parking lot gates will close 5 minutes before each walk and remain closed for the entire walk (approx. 45 minutes).
- Vehicles will not be able to leave the parking lot during the walks.
- The total amount raised & prize winners will be announced at the Celebration Assembly & Glow Party at 12:00 pm.
- Regular after-school dismissals will take place on this day.
- More details will be emailed to parents at a later date.


